

Glendale Cemetery

Marker and Monument Policy

FLAT MARKERS

1. Babyland grave only size: 20" x 10"
Single grave minimum size: 24" x 12"
Single grave maximum size: 28" x 16"
Double grave maximum size: 48" x 16"
Triple grave maximum size: 60" x 16"
2. All flat markers shall be granite or bronze only. No exceptions.
3. All granite markers are to be a minimum of 4" thick.
4. Plantings of any kind are not permitted.
5. Landscape stones and any other loose impediments are not permitted.
6. All government markers must be flat.
7. All flat bronze markers must have a base (backer) of granite or precast concrete approved by the Glendale Staff.
8. In-ground vases are permitted but must be approved and installed by the Glendale Staff.

UPRIGHT MONUMENTS

1. Single grave maximum size 32 x 14 x 36 (h)
Double grave maximum size 60 x 16 x 40 (h)
Triple Grave or Family monuments: Call the office
Please note: The above length and width dimensions refer to the base, while the height refers to the monument tablet.
2. All upright monuments shall be granite only. No exceptions.
3. Other restrictions may apply to the size, shape, color, etc. of monuments, at the discretion of the cemetery manager, depending on existing monuments in vicinity in order to maintain uniformity.
4. Any monument that is larger than 48" wide and/or 36" tall shall not be moved by the Cemetery staff. If the monument needs to be moved for any reason, a monument company will be required to move the stone at the expense of the family (lot/grave owner or Next of Kin).
5. Plantings may be requested by owners of multiple adjacent graves. Requests must be made through the Cemetery office and are considered on an individual basis due to a variety of factors. All plantings must be approved by the Glendale management.
6. In-ground vases are permitted but must be approved and installed by the Glendale Staff.

All markers/monuments require a concrete foundation installed by Glendale staff, which must be paid in full prior to installation.

Please note:

All marker/monument orders, including internet orders, must be approved by the Glendale Cemetery staff. Internet orders also require a signed waiver. Size, shape, restrictions, material, inscriptions, and artwork must be approved by Glendale. Inscription requests deemed offensive will not be approved. Glendale reserves the right to reject the delivery and installation of a marker/monument which has not been previously approved by the staff. Please call the cemetery office for approval information.
